#### CARE ADVICE: HAND TUFTED RUGS

All rugs retain their appearance and shape for longer if you remove dirt and stains regularly. If you have a light, single-colour rug you will naturally need to clean it more often than a darker, patterned rug. Shaking or beating a hand knotted rug subjects it to rough treatment that can damage the rug. We therefore recommend that you vacuum and air your rug instead. If you have a hand tufted rug, you can also turn it upside down and carefully beat the reverse side so that loose dirt drops out.

#### Vacuum clean often

Effective vacuuming is the easiest and most environmentally friendly cleaning method. It is also the most economical. When you vacuum regularly you remove all the loose dirt and dust. Do not use a vacuum cleaner with a rotary brush nozzle on long pile rugs where there is a risk of damaging the yarn and the twisted thread pairs. Note that it is quite normal for the rug to loose individual fibers when used, these are excess fibers and does not affect the general quality of the rug. If you want to get rid of excess fibers faster, you can vacuum the rug daily for an initial period.

#### Comb long-pile rugs

To maintain the appearance of your long-pile rug you can comb the pile of the rug at regular intervals. Do not use any kind of harsh brushes to clean the carpets

#### Rotate the rug

To get a more even exposure to sunlight and wear, we recommend that you rotate the rug regularly.

#### **Remove stains**

For best results, remove stains immediately. With dry stains, we recommend scraping and then vacuum clean the remaining.

Begin from the edge of the stain and scrape towards the center. Take care not to damage the fibers. Remove wet stains by laying kitchen roll on the stain. Then use lukewarm water and a cloth or sponge. Dampen the stain, soak up the water, then repeat the process until the stain is gone. Remember that hand knotted rugs in linen are sensitive to water, so take particular care with the amount of water you use. Do not rub the stain, as that makes it more difficult to remove, and can also damage the fibers.

On greasy and other difficult stains, you can use a PH-neutral, bleach-free cleaner. Sponge thoroughly to remove all traces of the cleaner, so that the fibers can regain their natural properties. Residual cleaner can cause allergies.

#### **Professional cleaning**

We recommend that the rug is cleaned by a professional cleaner, using the extraction method on a flat surface. The quantity and temperature of the water will depend on the material and pile length. Good ventilation during the drying process is essential. Shrinkage will be about 3–5%. Neils Posse rugs are not to be machine-washed or drycleaned.

#### **DELIVERY & FITTING**

#### **Delivery**

Our standard delivery times within India are.

5 working days approx for stock rugs An average of 5 weeks for rugs & runners made-to-measure.

An average of 12 weeks for products colour matched or made-to-measure at source

#### Inspection

Our Handmade intensive processes are integral to the creation of our 'characterful' textures and wonderful natural colours. They cannot and do not set out to mirror the uniformity of 'machine made' carpet.

Any variations in colour and weave in our hand-woven products are part of their 'handmade character' rather than 'faults'. At Neils Posse we take quality control very seriously and each rug is checked and rechecked. Despite our best efforts however the odd genuine error does slip through and strange things can happen in transit.

Please ensure that all products are checked and any problems reported within 48 hours of delivery. If your floorcovering arrives with damaged packaging, please note the damage on the delivery note before signing for receipt.

Neils Posse cannot take responsibility for problems reported after the carpet has been cut and fitted.

#### **Shedding**

All wool cut-pile carpets will shed fibres when new to create fluff. This is normal, not related to quality, and will not affect appearance or durability of your carpet. It is simply wool fibres released from the yarn ends where they are cut to create the pile. Vacuum regularly and shedding will soon cease.

#### Sprouting or pulled loops

Uneven tufts can sometimes occur in hand-woven carpets. Dogs, cats or stiletto heels can catch and pull loops proud of the pile. Carefully cut these tufts or loops with sharp scissors, do not pull as you may damage the carpet.

#### Crushing

Furniture can depress or crush carpet pile over time. This effect can be reduced by occasionally re-arranging heavy furniture so that the weight is not concentrated in one place.
